SEC. 3. REQUIRED AUDITS UNDER THE SUMMER FOOD 2 SERVICE PROGRAM. 3 (a) AUDITS.—Section 13(m) of the Richard B. Rus-4 sell National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1761(m)) is amended by adding at the end the following: "Each such 5 6 service institution shall annually have such accounts and records audited by a third-party auditor that shall submit 7 the results of each such audit directly to the Secretary. For purposes of the preceding sentence, a third-party 9 10 auditor may not include a service institution or sponsor 11 organization."
