To amend part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act to provide full Federal funding of such part.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "IDEA Full Funding
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO IDEA.
- 7 Section 611(i) of the Individuals with Disabilities
- 8 Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1411(i)) is amended to read
- 9 as follows:

1	"(i) Funding.—
2	"(1) In general.—For the purpose of car-
3	rying out this part, other than section 619, there are
4	authorized to be appropriated—
5	"(A) $$14,036,427$ or 16.2 percent of the
6	amount determined under paragraph (2),
7	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2019, and
8	there are hereby appropriated \$1,651,792 or
9	1.9 percent of the amount determined under
10	paragraph (2), whichever is greater, for fiscal
11	year 2019, which shall become available for ob-
12	ligation on July 1, 2019, and shall remain
13	available through September 30, 2020;
14	"(B) $$15,908,525$ or 17.9 percent of the
15	amount determined under paragraph (2),
16	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2020, and
17	there are hereby appropriated \$3,523,890 or
18	3.9 percent of the amount determined under
19	paragraph (2), whichever is greater, for fiscal
20	year 2020, which shall become available for ob-
21	ligation on July 1, 2020, and shall remain
22	available through September 30, 2021;
23	"(C) \$18,030,313 or 19.8 percent of the
24	amount determined under paragraph (2),
25	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2021, and

1	there are hereby appropriated \$5,645,678 or
2	6.1 percent of the amount determined under
3	paragraph (2), whichever is greater, for fiscal
4	year 2021, which shall become available for ob-
5	ligation on July 1, 2021, and shall remain
6	available through September 30, 2022;
7	"(D) $$20,435,093$ or 21.9 percent of the
8	amount determined under paragraph (2),
9	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2022, and
10	there are hereby appropriated \$8,050,458 or
11	8.5 percent of the amount determined under
12	paragraph (2), whichever is greater, for fiscal
13	year 2022, which shall become available for ob-
14	ligation on July 1, 2022, and shall remain
15	available through September 30, 2023;
16	"(E) $$23,160,608$ or 24.2 percent of the
17	amount determined under paragraph (2),
18	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2023, and
19	there are hereby appropriated \$10,775,973 or
20	11.1 percent of the amount determined under
21	paragraph (2), whichever is greater, for fiscal
22	year 2023, which shall become available for ob-
23	ligation on July 1, 2023, and shall remain
24	available through September 30, 2024;

1	"(F) $$26,249,637$ or 26.8 percent of the
2	amount determined under paragraph (2),
3	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2024, and
4	there are hereby appropriated \$13,865,003 or
5	13.8 percent of the amount determined under
6	paragraph (2), whichever is greater, for fiscal
7	year 2024, which shall become available for ob-
8	ligation on July 1, 2024, and shall remain
9	available through September 30, 2025;
10	"(G) $$29,750,664$ or 29.6 percent of the
11	amount determined under paragraph (2),
12	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2025, and
13	there are hereby appropriated \$17,366,029 or
14	17.2 percent of the amount determined under
15	paragraph (2), whichever is greater, for fiscal
16	year 2025, which shall become available for ob-
17	ligation on July 1, 2025, and shall remain
18	available through September 30, 2026;
19	"(H) $$33,718,634$ or 32.7 percent of the
20	amount determined under paragraph (2),
21	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2026, and
22	there are hereby appropriated \$21,334,002 or
23	20.6 percent of the amount determined under
24	paragraph (2), whichever is greater, for fiscal
25	vear 2026, which shall become available for ob-

1	ligation on July 1, 2026, and shall remain
2	available through September 30, 2027;
3	"(I) $$38,215,836$ or 36.2 percent of the
4	amount determined under paragraph (2),
5	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2027, and
6	there are hereby appropriated \$25,831,201 or
7	24.4 percent of the amount determined under
8	paragraph (2), whichever is greater, for fiscal
9	year 2027, which shall become available for ob-
10	ligation on July 1, 2027, and shall remain
11	available through September 30, 2028; and
12	"(J) $$43,312,845$ or 40 percent of the
13	amount determined under paragraph (2),
14	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2028 and
15	each subsequent fiscal year, and there are here-
16	by appropriated \$30,928,210 or 28.6 percent of
17	the amount determined under paragraph (2),
18	whichever is greater, for fiscal year 2028 and
19	each subsequent fiscal year, which—
20	"(i) shall become available for obliga-
21	tion with respect to fiscal year 2028 on
22	July 1, 2028, and shall remain available
23	through September 30, 2029; and
24	"(ii) shall become available for obliga-
25	tion with respect to each subsequent fiscal

1	year on July 1 of that fiscal year and shall
2	remain available through September 30 of
3	the succeeding fiscal year.
4	"(2) Amount.—With respect to each subpara-
5	graph of paragraph (1), the amount determined
6	under this paragraph is the product of—
7	"(A) the total number of children with dis-
8	abilities in all States who—
9	"(i) received special education and re-
10	lated services during the last school year
11	that concluded before the first day of the
12	fiscal year for which the determination is
13	made; and
14	"(ii) were aged—
15	"(I) 3 through 5 (with respect to
16	the States that were eligible for
17	grants under section 619); and
18	"(II) 6 through 21; and
19	"(B) the average per-pupil expenditure in
20	public elementary schools and secondary schools
21	in the United States.".
22	SEC. 3. OFFSETS.
23	The amounts appropriated in 611(i) of the Individ-
24	uals with Disabilities Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1411(i)),
